The match started @ 106 with an Orange pin, At 113 & 120, Orange decisioned Morehead to take a 12-0 lead. In the 126 match Orange fought a tough match & was pinned in the 3rd period making the score 12-6. Orange won the 132 match by a tech fall, score now 17-6. In the
